

Peter Rothstein – Short Biography

Peter Rothstein has directed 72 mainstage productions for Theater Latté Da, including 11 world premieres. Other recent collaborations include the Guthrie Theater, the Children's Theater Company, Minnesota Opera, the Illusion Theater, Ten Thousand Things, Minnesota Orchestra, Utah Shakespeare Festival, Seattle's 5th Avenue Theater, and Asolo Rep. He is the creator of *All is Calm: The Christmas Truce of 1914* and *Steerage Song*—a docu-musical created in collaboration with Dan Chouinard. Peter was named the 2015 Artist of the Year by the *Star Tribune*, Theater Artist of the Year by *Lavender*, and Best Director by *City Pages*. He has received nine Ivey Awards and has been awarded grants and fellowships from the National Endowment for the Arts, Theatre Communications Group, the Minnesota State Arts Board and the McKnight Foundation.
